I apologize for the delay in writing, and also for the briefness of this letter. I have been busy as hell this week, and I am now in the law library instead of eating dinner. I wanted to get this letter typed and off to you tonight. I have really fallen behind in my work with the transfer from Springfield, then the segregation in Englewood, and last the transfer here to Florence.

I believed that our letters regarding the Quill situation crossed in the mails. I hope that by now you have received my letter, and that it is acceptable to you.

I know that you have been busy with the AIDS/HIV In Prison Roundtable that is being presented in October. I was under the impression that the roundtable was from October 18-19, 1993. I received some materials from Jackie Walker Friday that say's the roundtable is from October 15-16, 1993. I damn near screamed. I have already written my booklet, Peace Be Unto You, which is being edited by the English Professor at Penn State. I am taking an english course there. I should have it back tomorrow. I am going to try and get it off to the printer Federal Express. I will have it in your hand by October 14, 1993. **WHEN ARE YOU LEAVING FOR SAN FRANCISCO?**

You are on my telephone list. It took awhile and some demanding to get you and alot of others on my telephone list, but I got it done. I would have called you, but the commissary has been closed for two weeks; thus, nobody has been able to buy telephone credits. I should be able to call you this week.

Enclosed is about 5 or 6 letters. Would you drop these letters in the mail for me. They are already addressed in government francked envelopes and need only to be dropped in the mail.


Also, I am sending you copies of my articles. Please return the original of This Anger May Never Die, to me. I figured you already had copies that you could use but just to make sure here is more.

Everything is o.k. with me. I've been off for the last ten days to complete some legal work. Unfortunately, I haven't had the chance to do anything but look at the legal pleadings I am suppose to respond to. I had one of the sisters here do an motion for extension of time for me. Thank God I have some support here. I've been typing grant applications for Haymarket, and DIFFA all week. Well as writing the booklet for you. I had to reduce the number of copies to about 300. I probably will send you 200, and keep a hundred for my personal use. It is my intention to have them forward to my mailbox rental in D.C., have them forward them to Jackie, and have her send them to you overnight. It's going to be a close call.

Well, I think I've covered everything. Please don't worry about the Quill situation. If nothing else I will send everything back to them I still have all of the stuff, etc.

Write whenever you can. Look for my call this week.
