Sex change for cousin of Duchess

OLD ETONIAN and former wealthy stockbroker Jeremy Charles Peel, 37-year-old descendant of Robert Peel, founder of the police force, and second cousin to the Duchess of Gloucester, is changing sex.

He is working as a woman in the Civil Service, undergoing hormone treatment and hoping to have a surgical operation.

His marriage to 32-yearold Mrs Sheila Peel, member of a wealthy French cognac family and cousin of Lord Windlesham, Minister of State at the Home Office, was ended last week.

The couple were married at fashionable St James Church, Spanish Place, Westminster, in 1960.

Mrs Peel, who was educated at a convent, is living with the two children of the marriage at their 13th century, five-bedroom country home, which stands in three acres of grounds, at Bentley, Hants.

Granting the wife a decree in the London Divorce Court, Judge Leslie said the husband, who offered no defence, was so anxious to become a woman that the whole foundation of the marriage had been destroyed.
