CONDITIONS FOR PARTICIPATION

In the conditions the term "Institute" refers to Fantasia Fair Ltd. and the term "participants" refers to the person signing the registration form.

- (1) Registrations will be accepted from all persons who have reached their 18th birthday prior to 16 October 1988.
- (2) Fantasia Fair participants are expected to maintain certain minimum standards of attire and deportment that are appropriate to individuals of any respectable group. If a participant's behavior continues to be innappropriate, the Institute reserves the right to terminate that participant's stay, refunding to the participant 50% of the charges for the time remaining at the point of termination.
- (3) The deposit of \$200/person or \$350/couple shall be treated as partial payment of the total due, as stated in this brochure and by agreement between the Institute and participant.
- (4) All participants who have their accounts paid in full prior to July 1, 1988, will receive a discount of 5% of the total cost of the selected plan (exclusive of seminars and workshops).
- (5) Except in cases of late registration, all payments are due no later than 45 days prior to the start of each Fair. If payments are delinquent after that time, unless special arrangements are made, the Institute reserves the right to cancel the reservation as per No. 6b below.
- (6) If a registration is cancelled, the Institute will refund to the participant all monies paid LESS the following amounts:
 - (a) Cancellation 2 months prior to the start of each Fair: \$60.00.
 - (b) Cancellation 1 month prior to the start of each Fair 65% of total.

(Cancellations after 1 October will be non-refundable.)

- (7) The Institute reserves the right to make necessary program changes. Participants will be informed of these changes where possible, and will be offered these alternatives:
 - (a) To accept these changes.
 - (b) To cancel participation and accept a refund of 70% of all monies paid.
- (8) The Institute reserves the right to make a service charge for a room/facility change made at the request of a participant once the Fair period begins.
- (9) Except where otherwise noted, the Institute acts only as an agent in arranging lodging and other personal services. The Institute will not be liable in the event of failure of contracting parties to honor their commitments. The Institute will not be liable for personal injury whether arising from an incident during the Fair or otherwise. The Institute will not be liable for responsible for consequential damages arising from an incident during the Fair or otherwise. The Institute will not be responsible for lost or damaged personal property.

BASIC PARTICIPANT PACKAGE

Registration Fees for the Nine-Day Fair covers the cost of the Fair provided housing (exclusive of tips for service); an inn provided continental breakfast each morning; three house wine and cheese parties; a brunch each Sunday; five seminar lunches; five evening meals (including Apre Follies Buffet); and, admission to all major events open to the Public. The Basic Participant Package includes all of the programs and events cited in this brochure except for those workshops cited as SPECIAL WORKSHOPS.



SPECIAL WORKSHOP FEES

SPEECH IMPROVEMENT - Basic & Advanced:

Basic: (Fee \$100) A 5 session program of small class instruction by an experienced, qualified professional. Advanced: (Fee: \$135) Individual instruction for 5 sessions (open only to students who have completed Basic Speech or upon approval of instructor.)

PERSONAL DEVELOPMENT - Two four hour sessions facilitated by a qualified professional experienced in the field. (Fee: \$50 per each session.)

PARTNERS & COUPLES WORKSHOP - This combined workshop consists of four hours of group involvement for old and new "partners" (signifigant others) followed by a joint luncheon seminar and group meeting for the couples in the workshop. (Fee: \$60/Couple.)

KITE FLY PICNIC - An afternoon kite fly (kites furnished) and picnic. (Fee: \$25.)

WHALE WATCH - An afternoon aboard ship to watch the great whales off the Cape. (Wear warm clothes.) (Fee: \$35.)

SPECIAL GUEST SEMINAR - A professional who has a particular interest in the paraculture leads a luncheon seminar. (Fee: \$25.)

Fantasia Fair is designed to help the crossdresser feel comfortable living in the opposite gender role. Fantasia Fair has the most comprehensive program of seminars and workshops available to the crossdresser. The blend of practical and educational experience concentrated in the Fantasia Fair setting is truly unique. Helping professionals familiar with our program are staunch advocates.

Each participant selects those programs that emphasize a particular interest. They may then expand their knowledge at their own pace. This is one of the many reasons why participants return year after year.

FASHION AND BEAUTY COURSE

Every facet is documented in this group of classes and workshops. It begins with wig care and hair styling. The proper application of makeup that will contour and highlight bone structure, re-shaping the face into a feminine image. Techniques are taught to hide those dark shadows. Attend a class in feminine body movement that utilizes videotape for immediate feedback. Fashion experts will provide advice concerning wardrobe selection. They will illustrate the use of style and color coordination that will flatter your figure and soften those hard features. A consultant is available to provide the proper use of corsetry and prostheses to add or subtract where nature failed to provide. Bring leotards and tights. Learn basic aerobic exercise. Improve your body language by practicing graceful body movement in dance. Proper nutrition and diet complete this exhaustive plan to enhance your new femme self.

SPEECH IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM

This is an extensive program taught by an experienced speech therapist. Small class instruction that include the following: the basics of gender speech patterns, voice modulation, elocution, and the relationship between speech and gestures. A worthwhile course for nearly eveyone. An advanced class is also available.

PERSONAL GROWTH DEVELOPMENT WORKSHOP:

Acclaimed one of the most important workshops offered at the Fair, it will happen again this year. Come prepared to deal with issues and emotions. Be ready to open your heart and mind to a professional facilitator who has the ability to penetrate into your psyche. This experience replaces apprehension with awareness that enables the participant to grow and be more comfortable with the femme self.

PARTNERS/COUPLES WORKSHOP

This workshop, held in a non-threatening environment, encourages couples to express ambivalent feelings about crossdressing. In addition to raising consciousness, a professional counselor will suggest strategies for coping and methods of improving communication. The goal is to promote a healthy relationship between couples.

LEGAL SEMINAR

Research has been accomplished by a team of lawyers into subjects that are a source of concern and misunderstanding in our community. Appearing in public, civil rights, use of femme name, and the legal impact on relatives are some of the issues discussed in this important seminar.

MEDICAL/HEALTH ISSUES SEMINAR

Each year a professional from the medical or mental health field presents valuable information of interest to all segments of the paraculture. Past seminars explained hormonal reassignment, cosmetic surgery, and sex reassignment surgery. These issues, and additional additional topics such as "The Standards of Care," living and working full time in the female roll, and relationships during transition are planned. The health care professional will discuss dealing with crisis, controlling guilt, and methods to survive compulsion.

LIFESTYLE SEMINAR

Developing the social skills necessary to appear in public is very difficult—usually learned by trial and error, sometimes with disastrous results. The advanced crossdressers who conduct this seminar share their experience, tips and techniques to help the novice handle most social situations and deal with any problems that may arise.

OUTREACH INSTITUTE BANQUET

The director of the Outreach Institute will describe the various activities that the Institute participates in. In addition to being the "architect" of Fantasia Fair, it is the only organization recognized by the medical/psychological community. This provides an important link for the crossdressing community. Outreach gives seminars and workshops for helping professionals, and offers a referral service to the crossdressers as well as the professionals. These are a few of the many educational functions of the parent organization.
