Biographical Note

The University of South Florida PRIDE Alliance (People Respecting Individual Diversity and Equality) provides an on-campus support system through which, by interaction with their peers, gay, lesbian, bisexual, transgender students, and their allies may realize their full potential. In addition, the Alliance educates the Uiversity of South Florida community by serving as an information reception and dispersal source in order to dispel myths and stereotypes often associated with gay, lesbian, bisexual, and transgender people. The Alliance, formerly known as the Gay Coalition, was founded in 1974, and is the oldest continuously funded gay campus-based organization in the state of Florida. Over the course of its history, the Alliance expanded to welcome lesbians, bisexuals, and transgender people. The Alliance people. The Alliance is run by the Executive Board, a team of officers consisting of two co-chairs, a secretary, a treasurer, an office manager, and a parliamentarian. Officers are elected to serve one-year terms. The Alliance's advisor is Dr. Nancy Barbara.

Scope Note

This collection contains material that chronicles the history and struggles of the LGBT community, both at home in Florida and across the country. Comprising this collection are publications made for the USF community as well as material published for the general public, newspaper clippings that have been culled from local and national newspapers and magazines with topics ranging from AIDS to society and culture to sports, and lastly, photographs of events and people. The material in this collection ranges in date from 1979 through 2012.
