IFGE is the only non-profit organization in the transgendered community which maintains an office with a full-time, professional staff and which publish *Tapestry Journal*, the most widely distributed magazine on transgender issues.

Our Goals Are:

- To monitor the medical, psychological, and psychiatric health fields that care for the transgendered community and to educate these providers about gender issues;
- To monitor and publicize legislation and changes that affect community;
- To provide legal back-up and/or referrals for victims of discrimination;
- To provide outreach and referrals for individuals and organizations within the community;
- To support research, educational, and social projects for the transgender community.

IFGE SUPPORTS THE COMMUNITY THROUGH:

Professional Outreach

IFGE provides representation and education to professional service providers and organizations such as the American Psychiatric Association (APA), the American Association of Sex Educators Counselors and Therapists (AASECT), and the National Association of Social Workers (NASW). IFGE also provides outreach and referrals for individuals seeking help, and provides financial support for projects such as the International Conference on Transgender Law and Employment Policy (ICTLEP).

Annual Convention

IFGE's Annual "Coming Together-Working Together" Convention is dedicated to building a strong and effective community through educational seminars and social events. The convention is held in a different city each year as a means of providing support for local organizations and increasing IFGE's exposure to the transgender community and to the general public.

Publications

IFGE produces and publishes educational video, audio, and printed materials covering the complete spectrum of transgender issues. Sales of these and outside publications helps to support IFGE. IFGE's primary publication, *Tapestry Journal*, has the largest circulation of any periodical on crossdressing and transsexualism in the world. It provides a forum for reasoned discourse on gender and related social issues. For many people it provides initial contact with the transgender community.

IFGE depends on gifts for a significant portion of its income. Donations to IFGE are tax-deductible. If you have an interest in gender issues, please contribute. IFGE is a registered 501(c)3 non-profit organization.

ENDOWMENTS & FUNDS

The Winslow Street Fund

This fund (WSF) was established in 1992 to provide an endowment to benefit the gender community. The annual income generated from the fund investments are given as grants for worthy purposes and causes that advance outreach, education and support in the gender community.

WSF is administered by three trustees who handle the annual grant-making and monitor fund investments. The WSF has already provided grants to: the International Conference on Transgendered Law and Employment (ICTLEP); Spouse and Partners International Conference on Education (SPICE); and support research such as Dr. Richard Docter's National Gender Research Project.

WSF's purpose is to give financial support to those individuals and organizations who make significant contributions to the gender community.

The Education/Research Fund

This fund (ERF) is designed to enhance our ability to communicate who we are and what we do in different media channels. We maintain a speaker's bureau to furnish appropriate spokespersons to educate the academic and medical community in seminar or classroom settings. We also provide for face-to-face interaction at our national convention by inviting the general public to meet with us to learn first hand about our community.

We maintain a list of people from the community for radio, television, and print media to tell our story. And finally, we reach out to helping professionals by maintaining a presence at the American Psychiatric Association (APA) Convention, the National
