

WOMAN INSISTS

"HUSBAND" IS MAN

CHICAGO, Dec. 21.—Mrs. Anne de Raylan, wife of Nicolai de Raylan, who was found to be a woman when she died, may be called to Phoenix, Ariz., where her "husband" died to make positive identification of the body. The woman declares a mistake in identification has been made.

Despite the assertions of both women who were "married to him" that he was a man, an autopsy at Phoenix revealed that de Raylan was a woman.

Mrs. de Raylan was formerly Anne Davidson and was a chorus girl for a number of years. She insists that her husband is still alive, although she wired to Phoenix without result.
