Our feet are still sore from the 60-block march held in New York City on June 22 to celebrate Gay Pride Day, but our head is swimming with the wonderful sights and sounds of the festive occasion.

The turnout was really immense -- an estimated 20,000 gays and their supporters turned out to march all the way from 64th Street to Washington Square Park down Seventh Ave.

Gays of every preference and persuasion joined hands in a show of pride in their chosen way of life. The march was designed to bring people out of the closet and to demonstrate graphically to the powers that be, that the gay movement is too big to stand pushing around any more. Gays can vote, just like anybody else, and many a politician must have had his eyes opened by this big showing of potential voters.

We joined the marchers for what turned out to be a lively but peaceful stroll. We can report that transvestites were out in force, including the radical and militant Street Transvestites. No really serious incidents marred the general good fellowship and unity of the parade.

It looked like a beautiful day for a parade when it started, but the temperatures climbed into the 90's before long, making some of the TV's wish that they's chosen less elaborate costumes.

A lesbian marching band, its members outfitted in overalls and hard hats, provided music for the marchers and presented the distaff case for cross-dressing.

Among the flashiest and prettiest of the marchers were a group led by Lee Brewster, who is right up front when it comes to fight-

ing for the transvestite members of the Gay Liberation movement.

Gay Pride Day, held every year, is designed to bring people out of the closet once and for all. This year saw the biggest turnout yet, so it seems to be having the desired effect. If you happen to be someone who's still in that dark, Victorian closet, all we can say is -- come on out and join the crowd! If you didn't march this year, come and lend your support next year, or organize such a march in your own town or city.

We skipped the big rally planned for Washington Square, because by that time our girdle was killing us. The park was so crowded that there was just no place to stand, so we headed for the headquarters of the Mattachine Society for some quiet conversation and drinks and stuff.

Another big event held recently was Frankie Quinn's Ball in New York, a bi-annual event held in the Diplomat Hotel. This went very smoothly this year, in contrast to some of the wilder doings that have characterized this ball in recent years. Everyone agreed that it was the highlight of the social season.

A number of attractive young people at the ball told us that this was the first such event they had attended, and we were glad it went off so well to give them an encouraging picture of what these get-togethers can be.

Right after the ball, some of us went to a straight diner where our finery caused some comment. We weren't hassled, but got a few hostile looks from the patrons -- and while they were giving us the once-over, suddenly it seemed that just everybody from the ball descended on the same diner! The straights were outnumbered, as we transvestites liberated the place.

We can't end this month without drawing your attention to some of the wonderful activities going on in Atlantic City, now that the New Jersey Shore resort scene is starting to swing for the summer season. Two great acts, Fat Jack and Danny Windsor, are packing them in currently at Nick Tally's and the Paddock. It's well worth a trip down to the sunny seaside to catch either of these top TV stars in action.

Now that there are so many clubs springing up all over the country, there is no longer a need for transvestites to feel lonely. We've devoted a lot of space to the gay scene this time around, but there are clubs and associations for just about everybody in the TV world. We ought to give these clubs all the help and support we can.

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## A LEGAL T.V. WEDDING





When the handsome exfootball star escorted his brideto-be into the county clerk's office at Wharton, Texas, noone gave them a second glance -- except for a few of the courthouse loafers, who favored the blonde and willowy bride with a few wolfwhistles.

The couple introduced themselves to the clerk as Antonio Molina, 33, and Billie Ert, 30. Nothing suspicious about that, certainly, in a state where many women are named "Billie," so the clerk went through his usual routine of asking a few simple questions for the record.

He found that the prospective bridegroom, a former Navy man, hailed from Brownsville, down on the Rio Grande. He was a big, strapping fellow, six feet tall and weighing 235 pounds. He works as a shipping clerk.

The bride sold wigs for a living, and back in the mid sixties had been a hair stylist for the late film star, Jayne Mansfield. She was five feet, ten inches tall, and a svelte 122 pounds. Her eye-catching figure was set off by a white blouse and miniskirt.

There was one question that the clerk didn't ask, because the answer seemed so obvious, so when he came to the blank marked "sex" on Miss Ert's application, he naturally filled in the one that said "female."

He could have saved himself a lot of redfaced explanations later if he'd come right out and asked what would have seemed a silly question of the bride: "Are you a girl?"

It developed, after the marriage, that "Miss" Ert wasn't a girl at all, but another man, and the revelation set off a legal furor that is still raging in the Lone Star State.

The couple made no bones about the fact that they were both men. They wanted to get married on the stage of a night club to publicize their





unisex wedding, but the vice squad, hearing of the plan, warned them that they'd better not try it.

So instead they were married in a church, the Harmony Wedding Chapel in Houston. Rev. Richard Vincent was the presiding minister. His church gives counselling to homosexuals.

For the ceremony, Billie wore a formal white wedding gown with a train five yards long. The groom was rigged out in a fancy tux. After the ceremony, Billie shyly lifted her veil and they sealed the ceremony with a kiss.

Since then, Billie -- who sometimes takes to the stage under the name Vickie Karr has been publicizing the union in a night club act in this country and Canada. Her specialty is answering questions from the audience about her marriage.

The newlyweds had no problems at last report. Asked if she plans to get a sex change operation, Billie says no. She says that her new hubby loves her for what she's already got.

But for the Texas authorities, the honeymoon was soon over. Just as soon as they realized that the state had approved a legal marriage between two men, they began to seek legal means of annulling it.

The authorities claimed that they had been hoodwinked, and if Billie was really a man, she shouldn't have answered the questions designed for the female half of a marriage.

Billie says there was no intention to decieve, and that she just answered the questions as they came up -- without regard for race, creed, color, or sex, as she maintains is her constitutional perogative.

Besides, according to the couple's lawyers, for a fraud charge to stick -- and that's what Texas authorities are trying to charge them with -- then something of value must be gained by the deception. They maintain that the license







itself, a piece of paper, has no real value

As far as the ceremony itself is concerned, the couple maintain that there's no specific item in the Texas laws that prohibits people of the same sex from marrying.

The state claims that the new marriage laws were based on older statutes that specifically prohibited two fellows

from getting hitched.

Whatever the law says, you can bet that lots of county clerks in the great state of Texas are now taking the time and trouble to ask "silly" questions of any bride who doesn't quite jibe with their idea of femininity.

As of this writing, the marriage has been annulled by one court, but the couple are fighting it still -- all the way up to the U.S. Supreme Court, if necessary. They also say they might sue the state of Texas if it keeps harrassing their happy home.


"Only two things can void a marriage in Texas," says their attorney, Richard Cross. "One is if a person marries a relative and the other is if one of the parties is already marri-

"There is nothing in Texas law," he continued, "which says that two persons getting married must be of the opposite sex."

Last year, Texas attorney general Crawford Martin ruled that clerks cannot issue licenses to persons of the same sex. In response to an inquiry, he said that there is no bar against people getting married if they have a license, however. He made that ruling in a case involving two girls who were trying to get married to each other.

As far as the minister who performed the ceremony is concerned, the marriage is perfectly valid.

"We marry souls, not bodies," said Rev. Vincent. "As far as I'm concerned, they're married in the eyes of God."



### SALMACIS

The New Social Society for Femmes of Both Sexes.

We've tried to make Salmacis different from the myriad other organizations that accept TV's as members. There are certainly plenty of them; and just another would have no particular claim to fame.

However, none of the existing clubs has taken the egalitarian view that all femmes are created equal regardless of apparent genetic sexuality. Most clubs, for TV's, try to make use of such females as have a desire, for one reason or another, to go along with the TF's fantasies. In the end the gals have rightly felt used, and have dropped out.

We take a different position. .

In Salmacis, anyone who has a stake in femininity is welcome. Moreover, we try to understand each other, and in so doing, perhaps understand ourselves better.

Our membership base includes all categories of femmes that one could imagine: among the genetic females, we have those who are sexually heterosexual, bi-sexual, and exclusively gay; married and unmarried; as well as female transsexuals. Among the genetic males ( who must have made some commitment to femininity) we have the complete spectrum ranging from mostly transsexual to mostly transvestite, the closet queens, and the fantasy queens; married and unmarried; with sexual preferences across the full range of human experience.

In fact our credo states, in part, "(t)he Society principally advocates social intercourse between highly feminine individuals and individuals with highly feminine interests. Its purpose is to provide regularly scheduled, interesting social functions; to



which, femmes, of either genetic sex can come and meet and get to know each other."

As a society in which TV's and TS's are heavily involved, we actively seek out the females who are tired of the Macho men, and who wish to establish some kind of relationship with a gentler, more feminine, member of the opposite sex. However, we are not exclusively a service designed to dig up dates for transvestites.

Many of our most active members have come to us from the lesbian side of things. Usually they start coming to social events to cruise our bi-female members. In the end, they stay with us because they find good friends and companions among the male-girls. Conversely, the male-girls, who were, initially, against the idea of becoming involved with the gay girls "because they might embarrass our wives and girl friends by making passes," have come to see that there need be no embarrassment at all, if everyone knows what's going on.

It is this unrestricted mixture of widely different feminine types that gives Salmacis functions their distinctive flavor.

At present, the Society is socially active in the San Francisco bay area. Regular meetings are held in lesbian and drag bars. Frequent social functions are held in the homes of members; and for the timid ones, there is a dating service, cosmetic and apparel counselling, and a telephone switchboard.



In broad terms, the Salmacis Society is a social society for bi-sexual and heterosexual feminists.

The Society principally advocates social intercourse between highly feminine individuals and individuals with highly feminine interests. Its purpose is to provide regularly scheduled, interesting social functions; to which, femmes, of either genetic sex, can come and meet and get to know each other.

Having been originally conceived as a vehicle for introducing feminine male transsexuals and transvestites to interested women; the Society has now expanded its boundaries to encompass all those feminine persons, of whatever genetic sex or sexual persuasion, who desire to meet other feminine individuals.

At present, the only real requirement, for membership in the Society, is a profeminine interest. If you feel feminine, appear feminine, act feminine; if you are interested in being with another femme; if you believe in the basic freedom of the feminine individual, in the freedom of individual self expression, or in sponsoring fem-femme relationships; you are more than welcome to join the Society. If you

are also a femme yourself, you are most cordially invited to become involved in the Society's round of social activities.

To define membership requirements another way; membership is specifically open to feminine gay and bi-women; to feminine persons, who have been converted from physical males to physical females (by surgery and/or by endocrine treatment); to male transvestites, male transsexuals; and to their wives and girl friends. Latently heterosexual women and heterosexual women who are seeking feminine boy friends are also invited to join.

Since the Society is pro-feminine, it discourages membership applications from persons who exhibit behavior patterns or express attitudes that are overtly masculine, sexist, or hostile to the goals of the Society. The Society reserves the right to expel, from membership, any individual who is found to be hostile to the aims of the Society. Upon expulsion, membership dues will be forfeited.

Salmacis Social Events

In order to get all the various types of femmes together, in one place, so they can talk to each other and begin to understand each other, the Society sponsors regular social functions. All feminine and profeminine persons are welcomed to attend these gatherings, without bias.

There are three separate types of social function, sponsored by the Society. The nature of these functions differ widely, and the rules of behavior and attendance vary with each type of function. So PLEASE READ THIS SECTION OVER CAREFULLY until you understand it, and do not offend the other members who have gathered at the particular function you plan to attend!

Thursday Socials

The Society has arranged to have open meetings on the first and third Thursday of every month. These open meetings are designed to encourage new, interested, femmes to come and get acquainted with members and their guests.

To back up these meetings, the Society sponsors a regular and aggressive advertising campaign, designed to inform new people of the existence of the Society and of the Thursday Open Socials. The Society also maintains an information switchboard, operated by a person who has a female voice, to help entice the shy ones to come to the meetings. So you can expect to see new faces at each meeting.

The Thursday Socials are held at various bars in the Bay area, as noted in the published meeting schedules of the Society.

The bars, which have been selected by the Society, are all members of the Tavern Guild, so there is very little likelihood that any femme will be harassed by any straight person.

The selected Taverns do not charge a

cover charge for the use of their facilities. However, they DO expect Salmacis members to use their custom; so, please do not bring food or drink to Thursday Socials. PLAN TO USE the facilities provided by the bar.

Thursday Socials are all-feminine meetings. Only feminine women and malegirls may attend these meetings.

In order to be sure that everyone will meet at a common level, the Society requests that all males (male-girls, TV's, TS's, sex-changes) come to the Thursday Socials in drag (female attire).

If you are a male-girl, DO NOT come in male attire; DO NOT bring a male escort; and DO NOT plan to dress at the Social.

There WILL BE NO EXCEPTIONS TO THIS RULE! If you, or your guests, appear in male clothes, you will be asked to leave at once, with prejudice.

Special Parties at the Homes of Members.

Occasionally, members may wish to invite a limited number of other members (and their guests) to their homes for socializing, cocktails, dancing, or games.

Parties, of this type, will be by invitation; and will be announced well ahead of time so that members can arrange to reserve attendance slips.

Although some of these parties may not be restricted, most private parties will be all-feminine. At all-feminine parties, malegirls will be expected to arrive looking charmingly feminine. Unless your invitation specifically states otherwise, DO NOT arrive in male attire, and DO NOT plan to dress at the party.

Because of the high cost of alcoholic beverages, and the wide variety of mixed drinks enjoyed by Salmacis members, all guests at private parties will be expected to bring their own refreshments. Please DO NOT ask the hostess to provide drinks, unless your invitation specifically states that they will be provided.

Be assured that your hostess will expect you to behave like a lady; so cool the overt sexual activities until after the party. If the party is intended otherwise, this will be clearly stated on the invitation.

Open Balls.

On infrequent occasions, the Society may sponsor open Dances, to which anyone may come, by invitation. At such functions, males may attend in male attire, if they wish.

However, events of this type will be infrequent; so be sure you understand the rules of attire before arriving at any function. Open Membership List

The Society endeavors to provide social functions of the kind that will encourage femmes, of both sexes, to meet and get to know each other.

The Society actively supports private dating, and such selective promiscuity as may appeal to individual members. Romantic attachments, between femmes, is always



encouraged; and to this end, the Society's Social Secretary will make available (to members exclusively) the addresses and telephone numbers of other members (or of interested parties who have asked to be placed on the mailing list.)

This means, that if you were lucky enough to meet someone who appealed to you at a Salmacis function, but happened to be too shy to ask for her address, you need not tear your hair in dispair! Arrangements can be made, through the Society, to get that address and meet your new friend, privately.

Your Help and Support Needed!

The Society has grown steadily since its inception, from a small nucleus of visionaries, to its present size and scope. You can personally help it dynamic by telling your friends to turn out for events; and by supporting the membership drive and the activities.

Membership dues are the same for all grades. They are presently set at \$10.00 per year (or portion thereof).







Singing, chanting, clad in festive and arresting grab, thousands of homosexual's and supporters of homosexuals' rights marched through mid-Manhattan sexuals and supporters of homosexuals' rights marched through mid-Manhattan past smiling policemen, wide-eyed tourists and blase New Yorkers who passed it off with a liveand-let-live shrug.


The march, from Central Park West to Seventh Avenue to Washington Square Park in Greenwich Village, appeared to be better organized, better financed and better attended than similar events in the past.

The police, as is their custom, would provide no crowd estimate. The throng, confined to half of the avenue by police barricades, stretched for a full 15 blocks, with anywhere from 600 to 900 people per block.

The organizers of the march, who saw the large turnout as living fulfillment of the oft-chanted slogan "Out of the closets and into the streets," said that their goal of 20,000 protesters had been achieved.

"This is where it all started," said John Paul Hudson, a contributor to homosexual publications, wearing the red sash of a grand marshal. "This is where I first heard the slogan: "Gay power!"












The parade began at noon under a bright sun. A police escort car led the varied contingents, which had assembled on four side streets. They struck out down Central Park West and Central Park South carrying banners, such as "Gay is Proud," and "Love has no Sex," and amusing by-standers with chants such as "2-4-6-8, We don't overpopulate."

Banners indicated that marchers had come from as far away as Washington, Philadelphia and Pittsburgh. There were established homosexual groups from churches and community action centers.

At least seven homosexual bars were represented, including the so-called "Leather bars," such as the Roadhouse and Frizby's, whose march-

ers were dressed in cowboy motif, complete with a horse rented for the occasion.

There were also, for the first time, organized groups of transvestites under the banner of the 82 Club and Harry's Back East bar.


"These people have rights," observed Gwen Saunders, the club's owner, who drove a blue Pontiac from which Ty Bennett, a female impersonator, tossed kisses right and left.


The marchers filled Washington Square Park for an evening of entertainment from 22 singers, mostly young guitarists who have been using the homosexual bars as a forum and homosexual rights as a theme.

It was not only a costume show and fashion extravagranza but a wild and wonderful time as well.










High fashion was the order of the evening at Frankie's fabulous ball. Each gal tried to out glitter the others as they vied for top honors as belle of the ball.












Frankie Quinn's ball featured this year some of the loveliest -- and liveliest -- TV's on the current scene. The event is held at the Diplomat Hotel.






I would like to take this opportunity to express my personal gratitude for you fine magazine and the tre-



We feel the following letter is certainly of interest to anyone facing the problems of a crossdressing transvestite in public today.

Dear People:

I have recently been appointed as the director of the new American Civil Liberties Union National project on Sexual Privacy. The purpose of the project is to coordinate a national effort to remove all laws which proscribe private consensual sexual activity among adults and to eliminate discriminatory practices which flow from the existence of such laws.



RON STORME OF LONDON

I am writing to you at this time in the hope of acquainting you with our project and enlisting your assistance and cooperation as a group informed and interested in this area of the law.

As you know in most states young people peaceably living in communes, hippies, homosexuals, prostitutes, marrieds and singles are subjected to selective enforcement of the criminal statutes which ban adultery, fornication, sodomy and other private consensual activities between adults. Although it is true that these criminal statutes are infrequently enforced because it is difficult to do so, it is imperative that they be eradicated as they are used as the primary justification for the pervasive denial of equal employment, housing, public accommodations and governmental benefits and rights to homosexuals. Of course these laws are used as a thin veneer for societal disapproval of differing modes of sexual orientation and life styles. Unfortunately, the disapproval is often based on widespread ignorance of homosexual motivations and activities. Prostitutes, too, suffer unequal enforcement of the laws because of society's disapproval. The police employ criminal "solicitation" and "loitering" statutes as well as improper harassment and entrapment procedures to ensnare both homosexuals and prostitutes because of the difficulty encountered in discovering and prosecuting their truly private sexual activities.

We believe the time is particularly ripe to challenge these laws and patterns of discrimination as a result of a combination of the recent landmark extension of the constitutional right to privacy by the Supreme Court in the abortion decisions, the recent surfacing of homosexuals who are willing to assert their rights, and the relatively new concurrent emerging tolerance in society.

In view of the general problems and developments in the area the following priorities have

been identified for the project:

 Removing criminal sanctions against consensual sexual acts between adults in private through use of litigation and legislation. Litigation includes filing of affirmative class action suits as well as defense of those actually prosecuted for violation of the statutes.

 Eliminating public and private employment discrimination against homosexuals through litigation, legislation and public education.

 Eliminating discrimination against homosexuals in public housing and accommodations.

4) Decriminalizing prostitution.

 Eliminating police harassment of homosexuals and prostitutes by challenge to the loitering and solicitation laws.

Protecting the rights of homosexuals to visit and have custody of their natural children.

In furtherance of the listed priorities the project will endeavor to mount a coordinated national litigation and legislation effort against the restrictive laws and practices, compile and maintain an up-to-date docket of significant past and pending ACLU and non-ACLU cases in the area, which will be circulated to all ACLU affiliates and other interested people and organizations around the country willing to participate in litigation; conduct an investigative survey of the laws and discriminatory practices in each jurisdiction; develop case materials, model pleadings and other litigation tools to assist lawyers in litigation of cases; and draft model legislative memoranda for use in affiliate lobbying efforts.

I am a French reader and have discovered your magazine in London. It was a great pleasure to find such a well illustrated publication concerning impersonation, as I am myself an impersonator or if you prefer a "closet queen".

I am 43 and love to dress as a woman since I was 13 or 14 years old. But I was in occupied France during the war, and it was quite impossible for a young, boy to buy feminine attire. I used to dress with my mother's gowns and shoes. It was not easy to find an opportunity to do it.

Since I was 20 I have been wearing fine lingerie under my man's dress and year after year, I improved my

collection and technique.

Today, I own a complete line of feminine attire, with shoes, boots, gowns, two-pieces, raincoat,etc., and four wigs. Most important, I have a wonderful collection of little things, trinkets, and some good gold jewels.

I think I can make up myself since I have been made up by a professional and discovered I could do a better

job by myself.

It is very important to wear artifical lashes and even artifical nails, when my own are broken. I always do it when I dress up.

I am married but my wife doesn't appreciate my impersonating and I am forbidden to appear as a woman before her. I do however wear lingerie and nightgowns if I am not made up.

I maintain two homes and it is quite easy for me to disappear 3 or 4 times a month to have a great day so I can dress in full attire. I have large mirrors and it is a great

thrill to see myself as a woman.

I have qualified myself as a "closet queen" as I don't appear in public usually, but I was invited a number of times by a girl friend to dinner with friends that didn't

recognize me at all.

In winter, I often walk at night in the center of Paris and look like a woman. I have a girl friend who is very amused by my impersonation and she sometimes walks at night with me. We sometimes go to a bar to have a drink and I am regarded as a girl by the customers. But I am not at home, and we get out when the mood is hot.

In the common life, I am a business manger in an important company and nobody knows my secret life.

I have been shaping my eyebrows since I was sixteen and therefore impossible to know that they aren't what they were and not too thick to be feminine. I have a strong brown beard, but decided not to have it removed electrically because I think it is dangerous for an amateur to engage so deeply. For the same reason, my ears are not pierced, and I never used hormones. When one has a good technique, it is possible to have a correct bust with a good bra, pads and a piece of medical adhesive tape. The main problem is to depilate legs, arms, and chest. I must do this every month with special wax. It is not painful and in Paris you can go to a beauty saloon and have it done.

I am very interested by the problems of the transvestite, and it is for me a great joy to see your magazine. I found, however, it is very difficult to buy F.I. in Paris, and the cost is very high.

You must continue your work and always be better because the Queens need such a magazine to encourge them when everything goes wrong. It is hard to be an



amateur without friends of the same taste and always the jokes and jeers when we look too feminine; when we have make up and spend a full day as a woman, and come again in the common life. We have feminine attitudes and gestures that we can't totally avoid before a day or two. We remain more girl than guy when we think feminine, act and walk feminine, and when our heels are far from our feet.

But I think we are far superior to the "others" because we can act both as man and woman, it is a powerful feeling, and it is necessary to be a Queen to know how

wonderful to be a girl . . . and also a boy. Thank you, for the joy you give us.

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






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
