About the Fling: The Spring Fling is dedicated to fun and friendship. To this end, the participant has a wealth of options, from enjoying quiet chats with good friends surrounded by the Boatslip's charming decor, to roaming Cape Cod's spectacular beaches, to exploring Provincetown's many delightful shops and fine restaurants, to visiting a friendly beauty parlor or two. There are lots of things to do, and needless to say there will also be many parties. There will be a box lunch program, golfing at the Highland links, volleyball, whale watching, sand dune tours, and a pajama party.

Newcomers and First Timers: Everyone who will comply with the security requirements and code of conduct of the Tiffany Club is welcome to attend the Fling. Membership in TCNE is **not** a prerequisite for attending. The Fling is specifically designed for newcomers and first-timers, with particular attention given to your security and peace of mind. You will **not** be judged. You will be treated with courtesy, respect, friendship, and support.

We do not require that you be crossdressed. If you are uncomfortable with being crossdressed in the company of others or in public, you can dress as much or as little as you would like.

The P-town merchants and townspeople know us and will treat you with courtesy and respect. The P-Town police are polite and professional. Should you have a problem, they will treat you and protect you as they would any other citizen.

Are you any of the following: apprehensive, afraid of committing a *faux pas*, uncertain about being accepted, concerned you will find a clique who will not include you, confused about applying your makeup, unsure about what clothes are appropriate or when and where you should wear what jewelry and with what outfit?? Your Big Sister will help you through all this and through the inevitable ambiguity of feelings that go with coming out! Our Big Sister program is specifically designed to help and assist new people in their debut.

Wives/Fiancees: Wives and fiancees are most welcome. Each year several couples attend the Fling. A couple will be hosting the Big Sister program for couples, so that a new couple will have another couple available to them for support.

Code of Conduct: The Tiffany Club of New England is a nonprofit, tax-exempt, nonsexual, educational organization. It is expected that attendees at any TCNE function will dress tastefully (whether in masculine or feminine attire), exercise good manners and common sense at all times, and protect the security and peace of mind of all.

Programs:

Jim Bridges will once again be coming in from California (on Friday and Saturday only) to provide his fantastic makeovers. He will have jewelry, clothes, hairpieces, and cosmetics available. A makeover takes about an hour and Jim is usually booked to the walls, so if you are interested please make sure you indicate (in the "Special Needs" section) on which day you want your makeover. We will do what we can to get you scheduled before you even arrive.

Sunset dune tours will be available every evening from about 5:00 P.M. to 8:00 P.M., leaving from the cab stand downtown.

Accommodations: Headquarters will be at the Boatslip Beach Club. The Boatslip is ideally located on the beach of Provincetown harbor, just a few short blocks from the center of town.

All rooms have private baths, with most rooms having two full-size beds; the remaining rooms have one queen-size bed. The waterfront rooms have glass doors opening onto private balconies overlooking the beach and P-Town's busy harbor. Streetside rooms overlook Commercial Street.

You can enjoy your favorite refreshments and dinner in the beautiful harborside dining room, relax in the intimate fireplace lounge, or enjoy varied entertainment and refreshments in the enclosed Beach Club Deck Room. You may also enjoy lazing in the sun on the beach, at the pool, or on the expanded sundeck, while nibbling a snack from the poolside bar and grill.

The room rate includes use of pool and sun cots (reserve by 10:00 A.M.), color cable TV, and coffee in the morning. The Boatslip has limited free parking. Spring Fling participants who register for four or more nights will be provided with hotel parking permits in advance of their arrival. Participants registering for three or fewer nights, or those not registering in advance, cannot be assured of having free parking.

Registration: We need your name (legal or adopted). Address and phone number are preferred but optional. Registration Fees: You do not need to use our accommodations to attend the Fling, and you do not need to attend the entire time. The registration fee covers the basic expenses for organizing the event, marketing it, and so on. It also covers the event hospitality room, Friday evening's buffet, Saturday's banquet, and Sunday's pool party and helps to support the organization that exists to support you. To gain admission to all Fling-sponsored events, you will need to present your event ID badge.

For the fourth year in a row, we have not had to raise our rates. The Fling remains one of the least expensive week-long outings in existence.
