Ocean today says: That Nicolai de Raylan, alleged woman, "husband" of three wives, and confidential secretary of Baron von Schlippenbach, Russian consul in Chicago, was employed by the Russian government to watch the consul's office and keep the czar's emissaries informed as to the activities of the Jewish revolutionary bund

Isaac Lipschitz, one of the heads of the Jewish bund, and a noted "underground worker" in Russia, recognized a photograph of De Raylan and declared the dead secretary, under the name of Mile. Racznowitz, joined the bund in January, 1905.

He said also that "she" had been made one of the "receivers" of the famous "dynamite fund" and intrusted with \$273, the receipts of a revolutionary meeting at the West Side Auditorium in 1905. For some reason this fund never reached the Russian confreres of the local revolutionists, but no suspicion attached to Mile. Racznowitz, as portions of the "dynamite fund" frequently went astray in transit.

De Raylan also had been suspected by Prince Engalitcheff, Russian vice consul in Chicago, according to friends of the prince.
