

# ELLIS GLENN'S TWIN.

Parkersburg, W. Va., July 15.—The defense in the Ellis Glenn forgery trial sprang a sensation this afternoon, when Colonel Wolverton, one of Ellis Glenn's attorneys, stated that they would produce Elbert Glenn, the twin brother of Ellis, in court on Wednesday, and have him testify in his sister's behalf. It has been thought all along by many that the twin brother is a myth. If he actually appears it will create a tremendous sensation.

In an interview today Ellis Glenn declared that her twin brother has been in the court room within a week, and was seen by several persons. She says he is a detective, and instead of being guilty of forgery, was on the track of the forger. She says he will have witnesses here from New York and from England to prove who she is.

E. D. R. Kinder, an attorney from Litchfield, Ill., identified Ellis Glenn as the same person who jumped her bond there while under a forgery charge, under the name of E. B. Glenn. He was with the officers when they arrested her at Paducah, Ky. The entire party went in and got a drink. Ellis took whisky. Former Deputy Sheriff Jayne of Hillsboro, testified as to scars on Ellis Glenn's head, and both he and Kinder described them, but Ellis persistently refused to remove her hat, to brush back her hair from her forehead or to remove her gloves to show the scars.

The State expects to conclude its evidence by noon tomorrow and rest the case.
