Both classes of members receive the monthly newsletter and all special mailings, receive full meeting location information each month, and have a voice in all Chapter business meetings; however, only Regular members have the privilege of voting at Chapter meetings, and eligibility to hold Chapter office. But, persons who are eligible for Associate Membership may elect the Regular Membership if they choose, with all the attendant rights and privileges. All Chapter dues expire at the stroke of midnight on December 31st, so please have your dues for 1982 paid by that date. If paying by check or money order, please make it payable to "Donna Martin." If paying by mail, send it to the address shown on the newsletter masthead, and please do not mail cash; payment in cash will be accepted at Chapter meetings only. Those who are not paid by December 31st will receive a "final notice" with their January newsletter, and be placed in the inactive file until their dues are current.
